💖 <u>Maths:</u> 😿

In Maths, we will be learning about doubles. We will be using dice to help us spot doubles and then learning how to add the 2 dice up to get a double.

E.g. 1 + 1 = 2, 2 + 2 = 4, 3 + 3 = 6, 4 + 4 = 8, 5 + 5 = 10 and 6 + 6 = 12. Please practise dolling doubles at home too! Phonics:

In Phonics, we are learning some more new digraphs. The digraph ad trigraph next week are: **'wh'** and **'cks'** Please help the children to find objects in your home or think of objects that begin with these sounds.

Please practise writing these sounds at home too.

In Topic, we will be learning about toys – old and new. We will be thinking about how toys have changed over time and comparing toys that the children play with today compared with toys that children played with many years ago. We will be enriching our learning on toys by visiting St John's museum on Wednesday!
