# Internet Safety for children – top tips for parents

#### **Explore together**

Talk to your child about what the internet is and explore it together so you can show them all the great fun and educational things they can do.

#### Put yourself in control

Install parental controls on your home broadband to manage what children can access.

#### Use passwords

Keep your devices out of reach and set passwords on all your internet-enabled devices and don't share them.

#### Search safely

Use safe search engines such as <u>Swiggle</u> or <u>Kids-search</u>. Safe search settings can also be activated on <u>Google</u> and other search engines, as well as <u>YouTube</u>.

#### Be involved

Encourage them to use devices in a communal area so you can keep an eye on them.

#### Manage access

Set your homepage to a child-friendly site like <u>CBeebies</u> and create a user account for your child on the family computer or device which only allows access to sites you've chosen.

#### Help them learn through games

Choose safe, fun and educational online games to play with your child that you'll be confident about them exploring. Disney Junior, Nick Jr and Fisher Price have good free of charge examples.

#### **Set boundaries**

It's never too early to start setting boundaries. Set some rules about how long your child can spend online.
