


Reception Weekly Round-Up!

Please help them find objects in your home or think of objects that begin with these sounds.






Topic:

This year, we are going to use 'Seesaw' as an online platform. You will be able to see <u>some</u> of the things that the children are getting up to at school. We will be sending out more details about this in the next few weeks.

Spare clothes and wellies:

If you haven't already done so, all children need to bring a pair of wellies and a named bag with spare clothes in to leave on their peg in school.

Milk:

If you haven't already done so, please register for 'Cool Milk' if your child would like milk. From their 5th birthday you will have to pay for them to have milk.
