Reading Meeting, 6pm 15th October



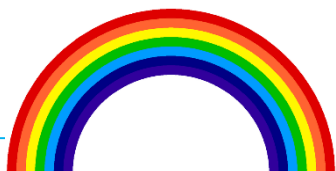
