### Sports for school Athlete Event

On Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October 23, the whole of All Saints', took part in a Sports for Schools fundraising event. Sports for Schools is a social enterprise that brings the country's top athletes into schools to encourage children (and teachers!) to be more active. The athlete we were lucky to have in school was **Joe Roebuck**, a GB Olympic swimmer, ten times British Champion, double commonwealth medallist and London 2012 Olympic semi-finalist. He ran a fitness circuit with every class before leading an inspiring whole school assembly.

A **BIG THANK YOU** to everyone who helped with the fundraising. The school raised a **MASSIVE £1690** for the school which will be put towards new PE equipment. We will let you know of these purchases when we have decided.
