# **Year 6 Trip to Coventry Cathedral**

At the beginning of April, Year 6 went on an educational visit to Coventry Cathedral to link in with our World War 2 learning in history and in particular, the aspect of Peace, Conflict and Reconciliation. The children have been learning about the effects of the war in both England and Germany and how after the war the cities of Coventry and Dresden reconciled and since then, schools in both cities became ICON schools (International Cross of Nails). The children had a

guided tour of both the ruins and the new cathedral and in the afternoon were able to take part in some art activities in the cathedral surroundings.
