# Take Heart: Collective Worship Resource

In our class Collective Worship assemblies we are using **Take Heart** - a resource produced Coventry Diocese and Coventry Diocesan Board of Education. It is designed to help children cope with the new normal, following the Coronavirus Pandemic, with **courage, compassion and creativity.** 

In the Bible, John 16:33 Jesus said, 'But take heart! I have overcome the world'. As a church school, we want to share the Christian hope that despite facing problems, God can help us through by sharing experiences and showing love to and for each other. This is about helping adults and children appreciate the relevance of faith in today's world. The stories and discussions aim to be Inspiring, Invitational and Inclusive. Each week we will send home a 'Talk homework' activity in the form of some thought provoking questions - this is entirely voluntary and up to each family how it is used. We hope your children find this resource helpful.

















#### Year 3 Update

Year 3 have settled into All Saints' brilliantly and have been working very hard in all their lessons. They've been working particularly hard in their English lessons and have been writing interesting and exciting sentences about our class reading book 'The Flood'. In history we have been learning about Lucy (the 3.2 million year old fossil) and how we have evolved. In our Science lessons we have been learning about fossil formation, looking at rocks and have carried out our own investigations - we particularly enjoyed looking at soil using magnifying glasses! Messy work!







#### Year 4 Update

As a year group, we have been writing and making our books. We have been choosing dilemmas and think of resolutions for our stories. We also took inspiration from the outside to gather some great vocabulary.



In Year 5 we have been looking at using our maths knowledge of x and  $\div$  by 10,100 and 100 to convert measurements into mm, cm and km.

Mrs Shahs group have been using their place value knowledge, multiple and factors while Mr Jacobs class went on a 1km walk around the playground.

In maths we went outside. The children tried to step 1mm, 1cm, 1m and then walk 1km. We worked out we would need to do 11 laps of the netball pitch and then walk 10 more meters.

They were then set questions to work out on their next lap.




In other subjects we have been investigating how materials change both reversibly and irreversibly, and in topic we have been looking at what makes a successful island including what human and physical properties we need. We have then used this to design our own islands.

### Year 6 Update

In Year 6, our topic this half term is The Early Islamic Civilisation.

Last week, we focused on an Islamic form of Art: Geometric patterns. This involved using a compass to repeat a pattern of overlapping circles. We needed a large amount of perseverance for this but Miss Cherry was really impressed with the level of resilience most of us applied in order to master this skill.


