School Immunisation Service Changes

Our local school-aged immunisation service has been working with NHS England on improving how vaccinations in schools are managed.

As part of this work, the School-Aged Immunisation Service Team will now contact you directly to request consent for vaccinations. The new approach will make it quicker and easier for you to give or refuse consent for vaccinations. This new process will allow the follow up of uncompleted consent forms to happen automatically if we have not received them.

What we will share with the school-aged immunisation service team:

When the School-Aged Immunisation Service Team asks our school for class lists, we will provide email addresses and phone numbers for parents and guardians of children who are eligible for vaccinations. The School-Aged

Immunisation Service Team will use these contact details to send consent requests and reminders to parents and quardians.

The Highway Code / School Keep Clear Signs / Zig-Zags:

Warwickshire Road Safety Partnership would like to remind parents of The Highway Code.

The Highway Code states: "You MUST NOT wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings." (Highway Code rule 238, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.)

School Keep Clear markings mean no stopping during the time and days specified on adjacent or nearby signs. The markings help prevent vehicles from parking near or in front of school entrances, to ensure safe access for children and parents.

Please park safely, legally and considerately and away from the school gates.

Message from our local PCSO

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our ongoing work to keep children safe, we want to raise awareness of County Lines – a form of criminal exploitation that sadly can involve children, sometimes even at primary school age.

What is County Lines?

County Lines is when criminals use children and young people to move drugs and money between areas, often using threats, bribes, or friendship to control them. While it might sound like something that only affects teenagers, younger children can also be targeted.

What to Look Out For:

Here are a few signs that could suggest a child is being exploited:

- Suddenly having money, new clothes, or a new phone they can't explain
- Becoming secretive, withdrawn, or noticeably changing behaviour
- Talking about new older friends or spending time with unknown adults
- Being picked up or dropped off in unfamiliar cars
- Going missing for periods of time or not saying where they've been

We are not sharing this to cause alarm but to help you feel confident in spotting the signs and knowing what to do.

If you are ever concerned, please speak to school. You can also contact Crimestoppers anonymously on 0800 555 111 or call the police on 101 to report concerns.

Together, we can help protect children from harm.
